The position is available within the LOEWE cluster project ELEMENTS, funded by the Hessian Ministry of Science and Arts and the participating institutions, starting at the next possible date and ending on March 31st .2025. The salary of the position is determined by payment group E14 according to the collective labor agreement of the State of Hesse (TV-H). The position will be located in Giessen, Frankfurt or Darmstadt as mutually to be agreed upon.

Project:

In preparation for the German federal excellence initiative, the LOEWE cluster project ELEMENTS brings together scientists from various fields of physics who aim at jointly unravelling the origin of the chemical elements in the Universe. ELEMENTS will answer fundamental questions concerning the properties of matter. On the experimental side, the project will benefit from the world-unique Hessian accelerator infrastructure including the international FAIR facility. The currently 23 principal investigators of ELEMENTS are affiliated with the Johann-Wolfgang-Goethe-University Frankfurt, the Technical University of Darmstadt, the Justus Liebig University Giessen (JLU), or the GSI Helmholtz Center for Heavy-Ion Research at Darmstadt.

Responsibilities:

- The Equality Officer (EO) is an ex-officio counselling member of the ELEMENTS steering committee
- The EO will be responsible for integrating equality into the daily research routine and work in close contact with the central equal-opportunities offices at the universities and at GSI
- The EO will join all ELEMENTS committee meetings to ensure the adherence of all measures adopted in ELEMENTS with the principles contained in its code of conduct
- The EO is responsible for maintaining an up-to-date knowledge on equality, diversity, inclusion as well as the compatibility of family and work related topics and spreading it on the webpage of the Cluster Project (<https://elements.science/>)
- In addition, the EO will be in charge of the organization of “teachers days” and similar activities
